Arrive at the village of Tempio Pausania, located in the mountainous center of the Gallura region and surrounded by dense cork woods, and appreciate free time to shop or wander the enchanting town, known for its locally quarried granite façades. On a panoramic tour of Costa Smeralda, you'll admire chic Porto Cervo, long considered the gem of the coast and one of the Mediterranean's premier holiday getaways. Make your way to the fascinating Nuraghe La Prisgiona, site of ancient megalithic structures symbolic of Sardinia that were developed during the Nuragic Age between 1900 BC and 730 BC. You'll find over 7,000 nuraghi still exist and that this early evidence of advanced prehistoric construction, along with their strategic locations, support the belief they were towers built for military and defensive purposes. Travel to Vigne Surrau, a striking, young winery built of glass, wood and local stone, and relish a cellar tour and tasting of both red and white local vintages accompanied by a traditional Sardinian snack. Back on your coach, you'll drive through San Pantaleo, a typical town framed by unique granite peaks, which offers you a contrasting and delightful glimpse into a Sardinia much different from the glamorous Costa Smeralda.

THE MANY FACETS OF COSTA SMERALDA - SMALL GROUP

DESCRIPTION

Enhance your shoreside experience with a Regent Choice small group tour. Hosting no more than 16 guests, these tours provide a more intimate experience and allow for more personal engagement with your knowledgeable guide.

Costa Smeralda is more than just a tourist enclave filled with shops and restaurants and this comprehensive tour does an excellent job of showing you all of the facets that make it a truly special destination.

Starting off from the pier, you'll first enjoy a mostly panoramic tour of Costa Smeralda and Porto Cervo. The story of the Costa Smeralda began back in March, 1962, when headed by Prince Karim Aga Khan, a small group of venture capitalists from various part of the world managed to acquire a large piece of land within the confines of the city of Arzachena. Thus was founded the 'Consortium of the Emerald Coast'. Everything that the most demanding form of tourism could imagine was created from scratch on what was then, an untouched area of Sardinia. The city of Porto Cervo has long been considered the gem of 'The Coast' and host to high-end international tourists. Today, it truly reigns as one of the best holiday locations in the Mediterranean.

From Porto Cervo, you'll completely change focus and make your way to the fascinating Nuraghe La Prisgiona. The ancient nuraghi of Sardinia have come to be the symbol of the island and Nuraghe La Prisgiona is one the first evidences of advanced prehistoric construction techniques. It has been estimated that over 7,000 nuraghi exist in Sardinia and they are the great protagonist of the island's landscape. Their shape and strategic locations seem to support the most common belief that nuraghi were towers built for military and defensive purposes and likely date back to 1900-730 BC.

Continuing on, you'll travel to the Surrau Caves and Vineyards where local wines are cultivated and produced. A visit here gives you the opportunity to tour the cellars and then enjoy a tasting of some excellent local red and white wines, accompanied by a typical Sardinian snack. Afterwards, you'll re-board your coach and travel back to the ship, en route passing through the village of San Pantaleo which is majestically framed by unique granite peaks and represents a typical Sardinian town, just a few miles away from the glamorous setting of Costa Smeralda.

Please note: This tour includes approximately 2-hours of moderate walking/standing and includes natural and uneven surfaces, especially at Nuraghe La Prisgiona. There will be a significant number of steps to negotiate. The tour is available to wheelchair guests who have a collapsible wheelchair, are able to make their own way on and off the coach and have an able-bodied companion to assist them; however, some areas are inaccessible by wheelchair. Those with mobility concerns are cautioned to carefully evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability. Weather appropriate clothing; sun cap; sunglasses; and flat, comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Guests must be at least 21 years of age to participate in the wine tasting. Small Group excursions follow the same itinerary and description as our regular group excursions whilst providing an increased intimate experience with your guide. Excursions which include transport via boats and/or meals will not be exclusive to the small groups and may be shared with other guests on excursions.

PANORAMIC TOUR OF THE NORTHEAST

DESCRIPTION

Explore Sardinia's fabulously scenic Costa Smeralda on a panoramic drive that encompasses a charming inland village and a coastal playground of the rich and famous.

Depart from the pier and drive northeast, deeper into the seductively beautiful area of Sardinia known as the Costa Smeralda. Here, the terrain is marked by huge granite outcrops and hillsides blanketed with macchia, an aromatic evergreen shrubbery. The coast is a paradise of powdery white beaches and hidden coves, punctuated by idyllic villages.

Stopping in Porto Cervo for a panoramic tour, you will soon understand the allure. The streets are lined with posh boutiques, sleek mega-yachts dot the harbor, and the ambiance is wonderfully chic. In the 1960s, the Aga Khan developed Porto Cervo as a retreat for his well-heeled friends, and it still lives up to his original intent. Porto Cervo continues to draw A-list celebrities and appropriately one of its trendiest clubs is called Billionaire.

Northeast Sardinia is just as spectacular inland, as you will discover by driving to San Pantaleo, a village that spills out from a flower-splashed central piazza. In contrast to Porto Cervo's somewhat recent development, San Pantaleo pre-dates the 20th century, lending it an air of authenticity and history. Rarely will you find a more dramatic backdrop, as the village nestles below a stark mountain that has been tortuously shaped by centuries of erosion.

Following a relaxing stop in San Pantaleo, you will transfer directly back to the pier in Olbia.

Please note: This tour is panoramic in nature with limited optional walking at the stops. The tour is available to wheelchair guests who have a collapsible wheelchair, are able to make their own way on and off the coach and have an able-bodied companion to assist them. Those guests with mobility concerns are cautioned only to participate to the extent of their personal stamina and ability. Weather appropriate clothing; sun cap; sunglasses; and flat, comfortable shoes are recommended.

THE NURAGIC CULTURE & PIERO MANCINI VINEYARDS

HIGHLIGHTS

- Gain insight into an early civilization found only on Sardinia.
- Walk among the ruins of prehistoric buildings made from volcanic basalt.
- Tour a winery and sample an inspired selection of Sardinian wines.

DESCRIPTION

SPOTLIGHT ON WINE EXCLUSIVE

Explore the ruins of nuraghic buildings found only on Sardinia, followed by a tasting of wines paired with foods that reflect the local cuisine. The archaeological site Nuraghe Prisgiona is full of preserved prehistoric structures made from volcanic basalt. The nuraghi are typically small buildings, yet they reveal much about the early civilization. As you walk among the ruins, you will learn how they were discovered, the methods of construction and some of the theories behind the Nuraghic civilization that thrived on Sardinia thousands of years ago. You will also visit the family-owned Piero Mancini Winery for a revealing tour of the vineyards, which extend into the fertile Balajana Valley. A tasting follows, during which you will sample a selection of characteristic Sardinian wines. They may include an elegant Cannonau with hints of wild berries, an aromatic Vermentino and an intense red blend with vanilla notes. The wines will be paired with delicacies prepared on the estate.

DISCOVER JOURNEY TO GALLURA

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit several towns in Sardinia's rural interior that still practice traditional ways.
- Browse an ethnographic museum where you may see artisans engaged in crafts.
- See where marble was quarried over the centuries to build towns such as Tempio Pausania.
- Enjoy free time in Tempio Pausania and snack on Sardinian specialties.

DESCRIPTION

Gain an understanding of life in Sardinia's rural interior, where traditional ways are still practiced. You will explore the origins and culture of traditional life at the Museum MEOC, an ethnographic museum in the village of Aggius. While browsing a faithful reproduction of a stone house, you will peruse exhibits of period furniture and everyday tools and see artisans engaged in crafts such as weaving. While pausing for photos in the lunar-like landscape of Moon Valley, you will see where granite was extensively quarried over the centuries to build towns such as Tempio Pausania, the Stone City. A walking tour along the Tempio's cobbled streets will introduce you to its charms. Free time follows, during which you might wander through the Cathedral of Saint Peter, parts of which date to the 13th century. You may also enjoy people-watching in the leafy plazas before snacking on Sardinian specialties such as prosciutto, cheeses and the traditional flatbread carasau.

Rarely will you find a more dramatic backdrop, as the village nestles below a stark mountain that has been tortuously shaped by centuries of erosion. Below lies the seductively beautiful beaches of the Costa Smeralda. You will also stop to explore some of the excavated ruins of stone structures that the indigenous Nuraghic civilization built in the Bronze Age. There are more than 8,000 of these prehistoric treasures on the island and they are so historically and archaeologically important that UNESCO declared them a World Heritage site. The 17th-century San Giacomo Church will provide a serene setting for you to enjoy Sardinian snacks while gazing out over the mountainous landscape.
