ECOLOGICAL HOMESTEAD LA PORTOFINES

As you follow one of the owners around the vineyards and olive groves, you will notice the wind turbines and solar panels that supply the farm's power. But the family's commitment to sustainable farming goes far beyond renewable energy. They have also adopted traditional agricultural methods that replenish the land rather than deplete its nutrients. Their approach to animal husbandry is environmentally friendly, as well. After touring the property, you will settle in for a picnic lunch of products made on the farm and nearby. The selections may include cheeses, fresh-baked focaccia, just-pressed virgin olive oil, honey and wines. The farm also produces a liquor made with the bluish-black berries from myrtle evergreens.

FISHING WITH NATIVES IN PORTOFINO COAST

HIGHLIGHTS

- Cruise into the Ligurian Sea on a fishing boat and watch the fishermen at work.
- Enjoy a lunch of fresh fish that the fishermen have just pulled in.
- Take a refreshing swim in the protected waters off Portofino, if conditions permit.
- Enjoy the views of Mount Portofino Natural Regional Park as you cruise its coast.

DESCRIPTION

Spend a day at sea on a fishing boat, watching the crew haul in the day's catch, which they will prepare for your lunch while you sit back and enjoy the staggeringly beautiful scenery. The captain and crew of your boat will describe a typical day on the Ligurian Sea as they fish for mackerel, bream, mullets and other common species. In some cases, the fishermen might haul in nets that they cast the night before. Other times, they may use traditional palamiti, which are long fishing lines with hundreds of hooks. Regardless, the fishermen are always successful, and you will dine on the day's catch while on board. As you will discover, fresh fish just pulled from the sea taste absolutely wonderful, especially when prepared in s traditional way. If conditions permit, you may have time to take a refreshing swim in the protected waters off Portofino.

DESCRIPTION

Cruise to Santa Margherita to watch traditional handicrafts being made and visit a farm in Portofino to sample delicacies made with ingredients grown on the premises. The ferry will take you to the former fishing village of Santa Margherita, where you will visit a workshop to watch local women embroidering and explain the history of the traditional process. The technique dates to the 16th century, when bobbin lace was included in the dowries of affluent women. Following the demonstration, you may explore Santa Margherita on your own. As an alternative, you might simply sit on a waterfront bench and gaze at the sea and the pastel-colored homes clinging to the hillside. Back in Portofino, you will walk to Niasca, a nearby farm with olive groves and lemon orchards. Here, you will have the opportunity to sample some of products made on site, such as crispy focaccia bread, olive oil and lemonade.
