ANCIENT POMPEII

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit the remarkably well-preserved remains of Pompeii, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

During your tour, you'll understand why Pompeii is considered the world's finest surviving example of an ancient Roman town, particularly since its architecture and customs were highly sophisticated. As you walk through the remains of the forum, private homes and shops, you'll gain a clear picture of daily life nearly 2,000 year ago. Marvel at frescoes and mosaics adorning largely intact villas, and observe everyday objects scattered about, nearly undisturbed since the classical era. You'll feel as if time has frozen here, especially when you see the haunting plaster casts of victims caught in their life's final moments. On your return trip, delight in the natural beauty and seaside communities of this coastal region and conclude your enlightening journey with a stop at an inlaid woodworking workshop, a delicate artform that exemplifies the victory over adversity of this joyous region.

POSITANO AND LUNCH AT HOTEL LE SIRENUSE

DESCRIPTION

Indulge your senses with Positano's spectacular topography, photo opportunities and cuisine during a visit to this resort city, and lunch at the elegant Le Sirenuse Hotel.

Next, a stop for lunch will be made at the luxurious Le Sirenuse Hotel, frequented by the international elite. The hotel offers spectacular views from its beautiful garden terraces high above the sea. After lunch, you will re-board your mini-coach for the return drive to Sorrento via the Amalfi Drive. Upon arriving back in Sorrento, you may browse the shops (time permitting) or return to the ship.

Please note: Mini-buses will be used to transfer guests from the pier to the motor coach parking lot and vice versa. On select dates, the Le Sirenuse Hotel has only limited seating available. In this case, lunch will be served at an alternative 5-star hotel in Positano for additional guests booked on this excursion. Flexibility is required, as traffic conditions may affect the duration of stops. The restaurant requires casual, but elegant attire. Bermuda-style shorts are acceptable; however, jeans and sleeveless shirts are not. Small mini-coaches are utilized for this tour, which is suited to guests that prefer less walking. However, guests in wheelchairs will require personal assistance to get around in Positano. This tour is not recommended for guests who are prone to motion sickness as the Amalfi Drive is a winding, cliff-side road.

After departing from the pier in a wheelchair-accessible vehicle, you will settle in for a leisurely coastal drive to Pompeii. The town will forever be known for the catastrophic eruption of Mount Vesuvius that buried it under ash and pumice in 79 AD.

Excavations began in 1748, although they were haphazard and periodic for centuries. It wasn't until the past few decades that the vast majority of Pompeii has been excavated, revealing a magnificent look into ancient life. Hundreds of public buildings and private homes, many of them luxurious villas, now stand as a testament to the vitality of Pompeii.

As you follow an accessible route through town, you can expect to see extraordinary mosaics, public baths, an amphitheater, the necropolis and even graffiti. Perhaps most startling are the plaster casts of victims that reveal the horror of their last moments.

Back in Sorrento, you will still see Mount Vesuvius looming in the distance as you enjoy free time in the historical heart of the city. While meandering about, you might browse the shops, pause at architectural treasures of interest and linger over lunch on your own.

With Sorrento being on the Mediterranean, seafood is a natural choice. If you only want a snack, try a slice of Sorrento-style pizza, which typically has a thin, crisp crust.
