WALKING TOUR OF IBIZA'S OLD TOWN

Once within the imposing walls of the historic Old Quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage site, you'll leave your coach for a guided walking tour. Behold the Cathedral of Santa Maria, a 13th-century Gothic treasure that features a museum, a soaring bell tower and a gold-and-silver holy cross that is over 600 years old. Follow a winding path along glistening cobblestone streets, polished by centuries of travelers. At the lower end of the Old Quarter, you'll find the spectacular Portal de Ses Taules, a drawbridge gate leading toward the newer parts of the city. With approximately one hour of free time, you may continue your exploration of the fortified Old Quarter, browse Ibiza's trendy shops or relax with a cool drink at one of the bars and cafés scattered along the waterfront of this ancient and iconic port town.

IBIZA E-BIKE TOUR - SUSTAINABLE TOUR

HIGHLIGHTS

- Ride an electric bike that allows you to pedal farther with less effort.
- Admire the dramatic scenery and coastal salt flats on the way to the island's southernmost tip.
- Enjoy free time at Las Salinas beach, where you will be welcome to relax however you wish.
- Swim in the sea, whose high salinity makes it easy to stay afloat.

DESCRIPTION

Ride an electric bike along Ibiza's naturally beautiful coast to the island's southernmost tip, where you will be free to enjoy the beach as you please. Traveling by e-bike couldn't be easier because its battery-powered, whisper-quiet motor makes pedaling a breeze, allowing you to go farther with less effort. The ride will be extraordinarily scenic, and you will pause for photos on occasion at attractions such as the watchtower that protected the salt flats long ago. Salt is still a major export, and as you will discover at Las Salinas, the water is particularly salty, making it easy to stay afloat. During free time at Las Salinas beach, you might bask in the sun on the long stretch of golden sand, stroll along the shoreline and take an immensely refreshing swim. Being surrounded by a nature reserve and forests of pine, the beach is picture-perfect; just one of the reasons it is so popular.

DISCLAIMER:

This tour requires 3 hours of cycling. Participants should be in good physical condition and be able to cycle and swim. Nearby, you will find Santa Gertrudis, a small whitewashed town that first became popular in the 1960s as a haven for artists. While meandering along the cobbled streets, you might stop in the art galleries, relax in a leafy plaza and revel in the serene bohemian atmosphere. The modest Church of Santa Gertrudis is worth a look, as it was constructed in the late 19th century.

ACCESSIBLE IBIZA ANIMAL FARM AND SANTA EULALIA

HIGHLIGHTS

- Admire Ibiza’s gorgeous natural scenery while traveling to a country estate.
- Join a workshop and learn to make the traditional herb-flavored liqueur Hierbas Ibicencas.
- Explore laid-back Santa Eulalia, a coastal town of beautiful, white-washed houses.

DESCRIPTION



Gain insight into the local culture by visiting a country estate and exploring Santa Eulalia, where you will revel in the laid-back atmosphere. On the way there, you will be treated to sweeping views of the hilly rural landscape. You will then sit in on an herbal workshop at a traditional estate, during which you will learn how Hierbas Ibicencas is made. This signature Ibiza spirit contains fresh herbal ingredients such as fennel, chamomile, rosemary and sage, which are grown on the estate. You will also encounter free-roaming animals that are bred in humane conditions. Not far away, you will find the coastal town of Santa Eulalia. The guide will lead you through the most picturesque part of town, an area of white-washed residences and charming shops overlooking the sea. Still, the best views are from the summit of the Puig de Missa, where you will pause at the hill’s namesake church.

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

DISCLAIMER:

This tour is designed to use the most wheelchair accessible routes possible. This includes step-free routes, shorter distances and no stairs. Accessible restrooms with wide doors for wheelchairs are present along the tour route. The vehicle used on this excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of wheelchairs and/or mobility scooters. Guides are not allowed to push wheelchairs. Guests needing special assistance must be accompanied by an able-bodied companion. Lunch/snack costs are not included. The number of accessible vehicles is extremely limited. Guests are encouraged to make their accessible shore excursion reservations as far in advance as possible. Guests wishing to utilize a wheelchair (manual or electric) on this excursion must provide the total dimensions (height, length and width) and weight of the electric scooter or wheelchair at the time of booking.

NATURE MEETS TECHNOLOGY

HIGHLIGHTS

- Learn how technology is being used to enhance nature at a botanical park .
- See the world’s first vegetable piano, a device that converts human frequencies into music .
- Delight in the bohemian atmosphere of Santa Gertrudis, an artistic inland town .

DESCRIPTION

Discover how technological innovations are being used to enhance the natural world at Spain’s only biotechnical botanical park. It will be an eye-opening experience as you wander through the gardens that replicate Ibiza’s seven natural habitats. Along the way, you will learn how atmospheric generators produce drinking water from vapor in the air and how a photobioreactor can synthesize organic matter such as algae to release its oxygen. The park’s vegetable piano—the world’s first—is particularly ingenious, as the vegetables act as biological antennas by converting frequencies from humans into a light-and-music show. Nearby, you will find Santa Gertrudis, a small whitewashed town that first became popular in the 1960s as a haven for artists. While meandering along the cobbled streets, you might browse the many art galleries, reflect in the 19th-century Church of Sana Gertrudis and revel in the serene bohemian atmosphere.

- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes .

ECOLOGIC FARM CAN MUSSON

HIGHLIGHTS

- Observe how produce is organically grown at the ecological farm Can Muson.
- See how traditional culinary items are made from the organic ingredients.
- Join a hands-on workshop and learn to use ancestral methods to prepare organic foods.

DESCRIPTION

Spend several relaxing hours at an organic farm, touring the grounds and participating in workshops that demonstrate how traditional foods are made. The organic produce is often sold right out of the fields at Can Muson. Chances are, you will see visitors picking their own produce such as garden lettuce, strawberries and herbs. The organic produce is also used to make traditional culinary products that range from virgin olive oil and tomato sauce to goat cheese and sponge cake. As you meander about the serene 16-acre farm, you can expect to encounter free-roaming rabbits, chickens, pigs and hens, which are bred on the property in humane conditions. Afterwards, you will join a workshop to learn how some of the organic products are made using ancestral methods. One of the most popular workshops will demonstrate how to create Hierbas Ibicencas, a renowned Ibiza spirit made with herbs such as fennel, chamomile, rosemary and sage.

TOP'S IBIZA BULLIT DE PEIX

HIGHLIGHTS

- Savor the emblematic dish of Ibiza – a fish stew called bullit de peix.
- Dine at a waterfront restaurant in the fishing village of Port do Sant Miguel.
- Explore Santa Gertrudis, an inland village with an alluring bohemian ambiance.

DESCRIPTION

OVERVIEW

Explore a charming inland village before traveling to Ibiza's northern coast for a delectable lunch of bullit de peix. Despite its rather petite size in the island's interior, Santa Gertrudis has a surprising international flair to go along with its bohemian ambiance. It's a wonderful combination as you will discover while meandering about the village. The village of Port do Sant Miguel is also small and atmospheric but it reflects a strong fishing heritage. Seafood is on every menu, especially bullit de peix, a fish stew that is so popular it has become synonymous with the village. You will enjoy this classic dish at a waterfront restaurant overlooking the beach. Although bullit de peix translates to "boiled fish" in Catalan, it isn't as bland as it sounds. Besides ingredients such as spicy red peppers, the dish is slathered with a garlic-and-oil allioli paste to bring out the flavor. You are sure to find it absolutely delicious.
